## Safety guaranteed

Operator safety is a fundamental value on which we work relentlessly.

#### PLc cat.2 pushbuttons release

Xpair provides safe release of buttons, PLc category 2. This innovation ensures that movements stop when buttons are released. Xpair thus meets the requirements of the **EN 15011** standard.

#### PLd cat.3 safety stop

Xpair also features a PLd category 3 safety stop button, as required by the European Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC.

#### Life signal in tandem operation PLc cat.2

Xpair ensures information transmission PLc cat.2 according to EN ISO 13849-1 and -2.

## **Timed installation**

#### Nothing to wire, it's all ready!

Xpair's receiver is delivered pre-wired, making installation significantly easier and more time-efficient! The external antenna is also supplied preassembled.

#### Simplified mounting

Xpair receiver can be mounted on its support in two different but equally simple ways...

- **#1 Magnetic mounting**: thanks to a set of magnetic studs, the Xpair receiver can be fixed without drilling! The magnets make it easy to position the receiver in the optimum spot for the radio link quality.
- **#2 Mounting by drilling the support**: external mounting holes are provided on the receiver casing; a simple and solid solution, since it allows drilling holes without need to open the casing.

#### Choose the best radio channel with complete peace of mind!

- 3 possible operating modes:
- > fixed channel with selection aid to adapt to a frequency plan
- > selection of a free channel at startup to allow more radio systems to coexist
- > channel agility: the radio adapts to its environment by automatically changing channel in the event of disturbance



## Easy to use

- > 6 double-speed pushbuttons to control the 3 main crane movements!
- > Excellent tactile feel of buttons for precise control even when wearing gloves.
- > 1 removable battery: time saving, operations continue while recharging! 40 hrs of optimized autonomy thanks to power regulation.
- > 2 attachment points for carrying straps: to each his own! Neck, wrist, shoulder or torso straps.
- > 1 rubber edge protector to shield the transmitters from shocks.
- > 1 protective silicone cover to preserve tactile sensation when used in dirty environments (paint splashes, concrete, grease...)

To conserve resources and save money, Xpair is repairable. All transmitter and receiver parts are replaceable and available for after-sales service.


#### # Easy replacement of a lost or broken transmitter

#### Xpair's simplicity of use starts right at the order stage!


You can't go wrong with Xpair: it's a single kit that can even be used in tandem! It can be configured on site according to customer requirements.



### **Pair**

#### Pairing transmitters

- > 2 primary transmitters can be paired on each receiver (the regular transmitter and the reserve transmitter).
- > In Tandem mode, 2 secondary transmitters are possible (one regular and one reserve).
- > Transmitter/receiver pairing can be carried out without accessing the receiver, so there's no need to climb up onto the overhead crane.
- > Pairing a new transmitter automatically replaces the previous one.

### Report

## Signal the start of crane movement with the built-in horn

- > Each receiver honks its own pattern
- > Users who recognize the sound of their crane's horn know they've picked up the right transmitter to start the right equipment. No more mistaken transmitters and unintentional, dangerous starting of a neighboring crane.
- > Choice of 2 sound levels

### Settings+

#### Selecting the best radio channel

3 options for selecting the best radio channel:

Automatic selection at start-up / Automatic changeover during operation if another channel becomes more effective / Manual selection from 64 possible channels. A channel scan function is available to help select the best channel.

#### Find the best trade-off between radio range and battery life

Automatic adjustment of radio power to limit battery consumption. Possibility of limiting radio range by manual reduction of transmission power.

**Secure use** - A protection sequence secures:

- Access to the settings menu, to prevent unwanted modifications
- Start-up to limit access to the equipment.

#### Install the Tandem mode with different setting options

Selection of overhead cranes A and B. Automatic or voluntary release of an overhead crane during shutdown. Automatic shutdown of the second overhead crane in the event of loss of radio link with the first.

#### Manage standby mode

Standby so that the transmitter switches off or not after an inactivity timeout from 10 s to 99 min.


